World-class Infrastructure & Facilities

Wi-Fi Enabled Campus

The whole campus of CVRU is equipped with Wi-Fi facility. The university has 10 MBPS fiber optic lines.

Moreover, BSNL communication towers have also been installed which provide 3G and 4G services. The university campus has also been upgraded in the areas of wireless facility where the students as well as faculty can connect to the internet. This helps them in research and to gain knowledge of the latest developments with regard to their respective fields. The Wi-Fi facility is free for all. This not only assists them in their studies but also opens a world of knowledge & information and provides international connectivity to them. In today's world, internet not only helps the student in their studies but also contributes in their comprehensive development. **CVRU is the first university to have a Wi-Fi campus in the state of Chhattisgarh.**

Security Provisions in the Campus and Hostel Premises/Digital Cameras

1. To maintain the security and peaceful environment of campus and hostel, they have 24-hour availability of assistant warden in hostel and four security officers and 12 security guards for administrative block and academic areas.
2. Security cameras are installed on the main entrance

gate to capture images and monitor activities from day to night. The cameras are also placed on engineering building and administrative block.

3. Bus service is offered to provide hassle-free and safe transportation. Parents are urged to convince their wards to travel in the college buses only, in view of safety issues on the highway. We also provide special pre-arranged transportation services for field trips and sporting events within the state.

Transport Facilities

The university runs a fleet of 14 buses to help students and staff members commute back and forth from regions around the city. The bus service is available over a 35 km radius around the institute. A nominal fee is collected for the transportation on a yearly basis from the students. Details of the routes and their respective timings are also available.



Conference Hall

A state-of-the-art 300-seater conference hall has also been set up with requisite acoustics and audio-video facilities.



Moot Court

CVRU campus provides the facility of Moot Court with a capacity to accommodate 40 people. This is the first university in Chhattisgarh to have a Moot Court.



CVRU-NSDC Skill Development Academy

Education is an all-round growth of an individual. It enables the students to be successful in their endeavours and carve their own niche in the world. Our collaboration with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) ensures that our students are not only academically strong but also develop vocational skills that would give them an edge in the professional sphere. By partnering with National Programme on Technology and Enhanced Learning (NPTEL), we have E-Learning through online web/video courses by IIT faculties to supplement our own central library stock of E-Learning material, which is easily accessible to the students. Corporate tie-ups facilitate industrial visits and tours for our students' exposure to industrial environment. Moreover, seminars, lectures, conferences, quizzes, training programmes, workshops and other skill-oriented personality development programmes are held on a regular basis, to ensure the growth of leadership skills in our students. There is also an active contribution in various state level and national level projects by CVRU to bridge the gap between academic and skill development.



Dispensary - Medical Facility/Health Centre

The university has its own health centre and dispensary comprising of two full time medical superintendents, i.e., one chief medical officer, Dr. Avijit Royzada (MD) and one medical supervisor to cater to the needs of the medical services. The CVRU health centre and the dispensary of the university within its premises offer full time medical facilities for students, faculties, non-teaching staff, administrative staff and other employees of the university. The dispensary provides service in the hostels and also extends its emergency services throughout the campus.



One medical officer and one assistant medical officer along with a medical compounder are appointed to take care of CVRU health centre and help to avail the medical facility for each and everyone in the university premises. The health centre of the university consists of a complete first aid facility, primary medical treatment facility as well as some of the diagnostic equipment and pharmaceutical medical store.

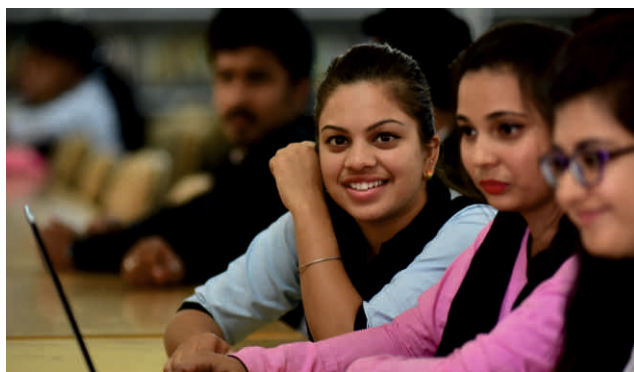
The university campus is always ready to face a medical emergency by having a separate dispensary with a staff of one MD doctor, one BMS doctor and one nurse. The dispensary is well equipped for emergency first aid and provides 24-hour services. Besides this, we are also having an MOU with Sai Baba Nursing Home at Ring Road, Bilaspur for special cases and serious problems. The students of our university are recommended and referred for the further treatment, free of cost.

Video Conferencing

Dr. C.V. Raman University is among one of the top Indian universities which is equipped with high-tech amenities like video conferencing. The university believes in consistently upgrading itself with the latest technology for better and faster communication.

Digital Attendance/Biometric

Dr. C.V. Raman University also has the facility of digital signature for the attendance of employees. This facility reduces the paper work and is a faster way to maintain attendance and punctuality.



Bank & ATM

CVRU has students from different parts of the country. In this situation, students need proper banking facilities considering their monetary requirements. So to help students in such a situation and considering their safety, the university has Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) of leading banks like the Bank of



India installed in the campus. The Bank of India has a branch inside the university campus which provides banking facilities to the students and faculties of CVRU. All banking facilities such as fixed deposits, drafts, deposits, withdrawals, etc., are provided to the students residing at hostels. CVRU has taken a special care in providing educational loans to the deserving students.

Solar Power

The university has installed solar power generation system of 10 KW for the renewable use of energy in the departments. Initiatives towards energy conservation includes the setting up of a 5 KW (space) capacity Solar Photovoltaic cell facility which is used in the campus.



BioTech Park

The university campus has a herbal garden with near about 425 medicinal plants of essential medicinal use and for research purpose. This also includes 20 different other types of herbs and shrubs. It significantly contributes to the "Go Green Campus" plan of the University.

Biogas

Biogas plant with capacity of 100 cubic cm that handles 300 to 400 kg of waste has been installed and the biogas produced has been used in the labs of the departments.

Rain Water Harvesting

A facility for ground water reverse osmosis with capacity of 500 litre per hour is also available. 50% of rainfall is harvested and stored in a 15 lakh liter capacity tank for use in hydraulics and other laboratories. It is done through mini soak-pits in several places of CVRU campus.

Power House

CVRU has Electrical CSEB Sub-Station with three generators. The first one is 125 KVA, the second is 25 KVA and the third is a 10 KVA generator.



Guest House

A comfortable, modern guesthouse has been constructed in 2011 which has more than 10 well furnished rooms with attached baths, a dining area, recreation area, lounges and meeting rooms to host guests of the university.

Residential Accommodation for Vice Chancellor and Registrar

Fully-fledged residential bungalows in the CVRU campus are provided to the Vice Chancellor and the Registrar of the university.

Online Live Lectures

Dr. C.V. Raman University provides online live lectures to students across the country through distance learning centres. This initiative provides a great opportunity for students to learn in a live interactive

mode and increases the university's reach to various geographical locations across India. The aim of the online live lectures is to bring a more personalized approach to distance and open learning by connecting students to faculty members through weekly live interactions. These lectures also endeavour to instill self-employment skills in a large section of people through vocational courses like diploma in computer applications.

Girls Common Room

The university has established a spacious and comfortable common room for the female students.

This space has been designed to give female students a place to relax, offer prayers, study and have informal discussions in the free time available. Daily newspapers, magazines, periodicals and journals are available for leisure reading.



Hostels and Mess

The university provides hostel facility for both boys and girls. There are two hostels with accommodating strength of about 500 for boys and one hostel with accommodating strength of 150 for girls. Hostels are spacious, safe and secured, with a cordial environment and surrounded by pleasant landscapes. The campus incorporates residential buildings in close proximity to the departments, library and classrooms to facilitate easy access. All rooms are well furnished with an attached bathroom.

Mess facility is also available for all our students and faculties. Students are provided with basic amenities like a cot, a table, a chair and a cupboard in their respective rooms. The rooms are spacious and airy with a full view of the lush greenery outside the block perimeters. TV sets, carrom boards and other recreational and amusement facilities are also provided. Hostels have a 24-hour water supply and a generator to ensure constant power supply to mess and common rooms. It also facilitates hygienic, clean and healthy environment in the university campus. Collection and disposal of waste is carried outside the university area, with the help of the workers and vehicles. Water filters for drinking water are also equipped for students. Hostel campus maintenance like cleaning, sweeping and pest control is outsourced. Electrical repairs and security services are available round the clock.

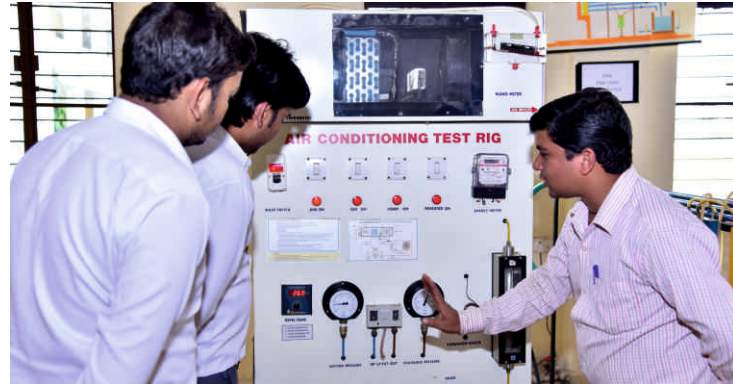


Canteen

J.P. Choubey Central Library

The C.V. Raman University's Central Library is the soul of the institution and has an extensive collection of books, scientific and technical journals and electronic reference materials for satisfying the academic and research needs of students and faculty. The Library and Information Centre consists of a Reference Section, Circulation Section, Reading Section, Periodical Section and Digital Library. The university library has automated all its library activities through KOHA Software Package to provide an effective and a wide range of academic resources such as books, journals, online databases, DVDs and other useful materials. The Central Library spreads over to ground plus first floor with an area of 10,000 sq.ft. It is well protected with fire alarm and has CCTV surveillance. It has a specialized collection of study material in Sciences, Engineering and Technology, Biotechnology, Humanities, Social Sciences, Law and Management ranging from printed books, e-books, back volumes and CDs/DVDs. The Central Library subscribes to national and international journals in print and electronic format. The library has a video conferencing facility and NPTEL video courses.

90.4 FM Radio Raman at CVRU Campus

Radio Raman is the first community radio station set up by a university in India. The advent of this station has helped people connect with each other in a better manner and become more aware about the various social, political and economic issues that they are facing. The online live lectures help the university in connecting with around 50,000 students who are currently enrolled with CVRU's Institute of Open and Distance Education (IODE). So, a more personalized approach has been adopted even in distance education wherein students get to interact with the university's faculties on a regular basis. Live lectures can be accessed via archive. So, students who are unable to attend live lectures can still avail the educational content at a later date. Need based baseline survey is conducted on a regular basis and then not only students but also their family members are targeted through content which highlights women and children specific issues. Thus, a holistic approach towards the empowerment of the whole society has been adopted through the radio station.

Key Achievements: The community radio station reaches out to people in 100 villages of Bilaspur, thereby spreading knowledge and awareness about basic rights among all the people staying in those remote areas.

Availability of Playgrounds and Other Facilities of Sports

Dr. C.V. Raman University offers a variety of sports facilities on the campus. World-class facilities for cricket, hockey, football, kabaddi, kho-kho, volleyball, table tennis, basketball and badminton are made available to the students. The college also houses a small gymnasium to encourage students to stay fit and healthy. The university employs specially trained and qualified instructors for yoga and other sports to guide the students on weekends. Students with exceptional sports abilities are motivated to participate in competitions at inter-college tournaments and national level. The university has used its space to provide sports infrastructure, thereby contributing towards physical well being of the students. The playground has a separate portion where a basketball court is built. The ground is also used for football matches and a separate ground is present for volleyball, badminton and hockey. The playground has been developed to facilitate the hosting of big tournaments.

Indoor Games: As sports are not only limited to the outdoors and considering the promising future in indoor games, the university has set up an indoor auditorium dedicated to indoor games. Apart from table tennis, other games like carrom and chess are also provided with separate areas so as to enable the students to indulge in the games with convincingly supportive environment. Students are also provided with necessary sports equipment.

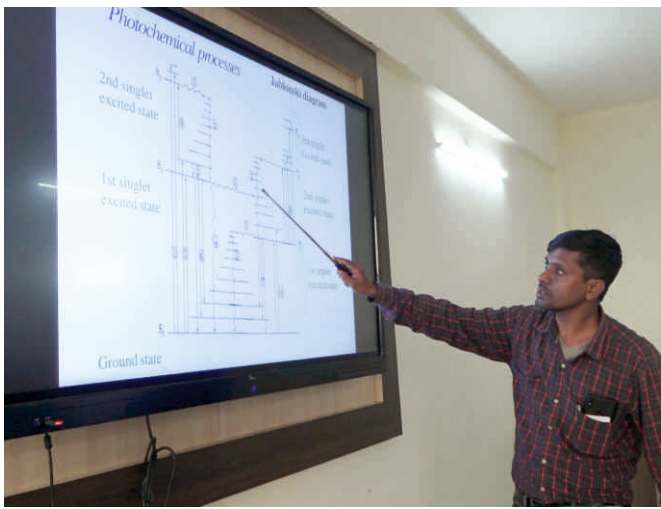
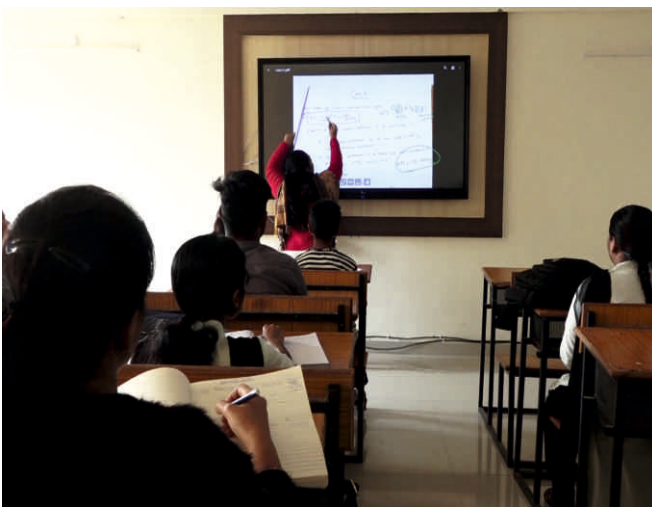


Sports Activities of the CVRU Campus
