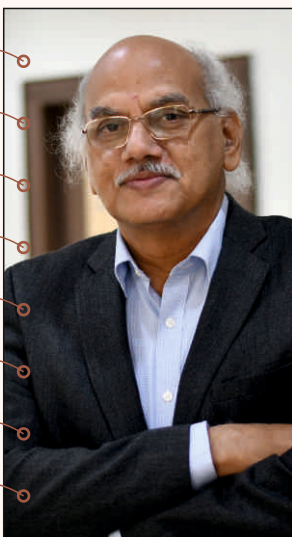

I welcome all the students and aspiring youngsters to join us to grow a new harvest of professionals, capable enough to change the market tides in India's side.

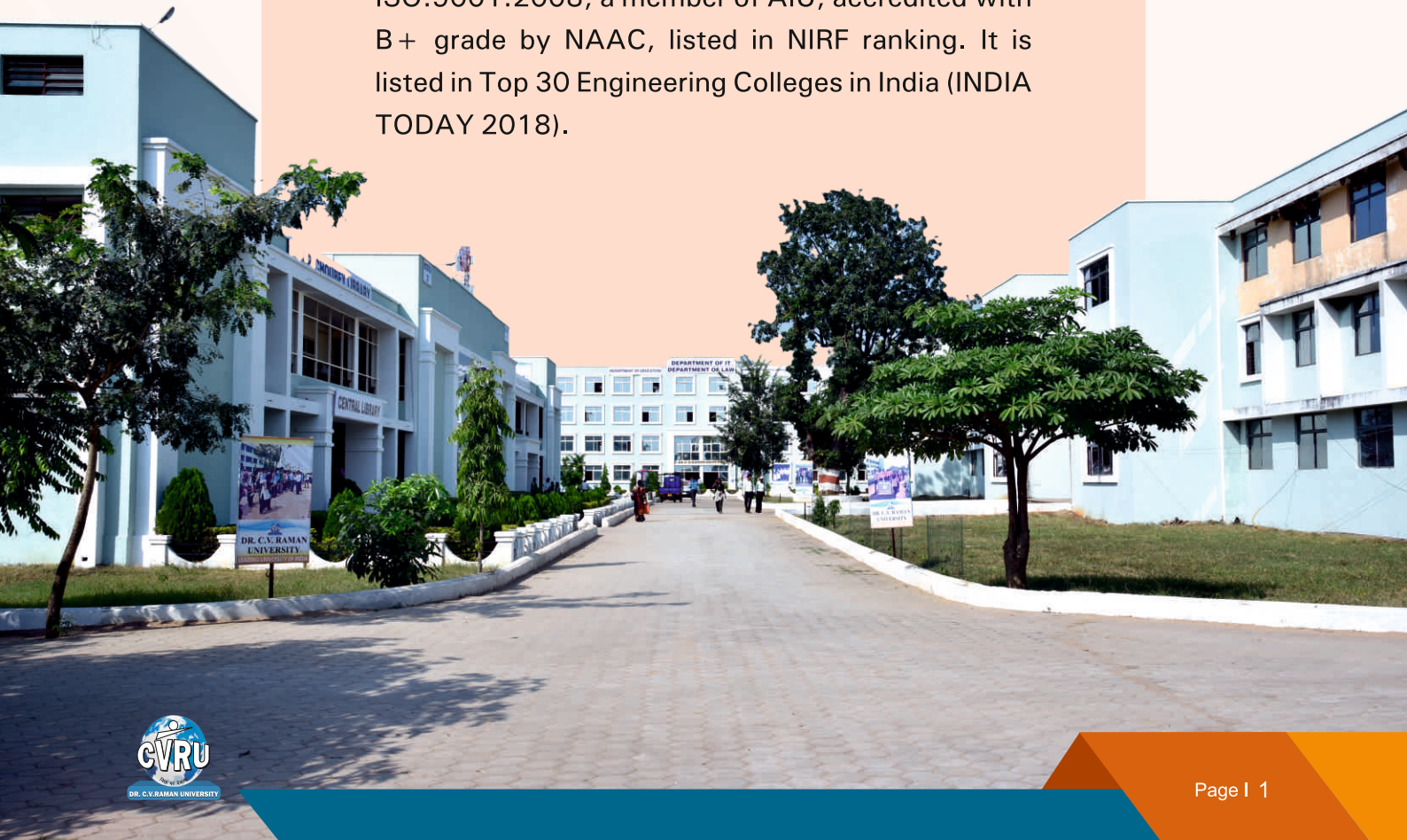
