- That the deponents have fully understood all the clauses, terms and conditions as stipulated in the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
- 3. That the Higher Educational Institution shall scrupulously abide by all the terms and conditions as stipulated under University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments along with the provisions mentioned in its Annexures.
- 4. That the Higher Educational Institution proposes to offer Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Postgraduate diploma programmes under the discipline of Management, Computer Applications and Travel and Tourism from academic year

2024-25, academic session beginning September, 2024 (revised from July-August, 2024) and onwards in adherence to all the norms and standards stipulated by AICTE and/or mentioned in AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2024-27:

- a) Master of Business Administration (MBA)
- b) Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)
- 5. That the Higher Educational Institution after getting programme wise recognition of above mentioned Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Postgraduate diploma programmes under the discipline of Management, Computer Applications and Travel and Tourism from academic year 2024-25, academic session beginning September, 2024 (revised from July-August, 2024) and onwards shall adhere to the following:
 - a. The entry level qualifications, curriculum, teaching-learning scheme, pattern of question papers (for end semester examination or term end examination), pass or fail criteria followed by the HEI are same for conventional programme and Open and Distance Learning programme, as applicable.
 - b. Availability of good quality Self Learning Material/E- Learning Material and regular updating of Learning Material from the perspective of improving quality and learner support.
 - c. Appointment of requisite number of full time dedicated faculty exclusively for above mentioned ODL/ online programmes, as stipulated under Annexure-IV of University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
 - d. Arrangement of regular assignments to enrolled candidates and their evaluation/feedback.
 - e. The examination system shall be proctored to ensure transparency and security.
 - f. Model curriculum framework/model curriculum and credit framework as defined by AICTE.
 - g. Ensure the delivery of Self Learning Material to learners for ODL programmes within a fortnight from the date of admission (for ODL programmes).
 - h. Availability of learning management system which tracks the delivery of programme, learner's engagement, assessment and results (for Online programmes).
- 6. The Higher Educational Institution shall ensure that learning materials are developed in accordance with the Quality Standard/Guidelines, Curriculum and Credit framework as issued by the Commission and AICTE from time to time.



 All Institution shall fulfill the following general conditions:
 - The management shall provide adequate funds for development of infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
 - 2. The Eligibility Criteria for admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
 - The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council
 from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form. If found so, appropriate action as
 per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution
 - The management of the Institution shall not discontinue any course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
 - No excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
 - The Institution shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any other Indian and / or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical
 courses without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified
 regulations shall be initiated against the Institution
 - The Institution shall not conduct any course(s) as specified in the Approval Process Handbook without prior permission / approval of AICTE.
 If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
 - 8. The Institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers / extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution / university / organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
 - The accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council
 or persons authorized by it.

10. Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in given time frame and selection shall be done according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. The Institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the Institution and courses / programs being conducted, Fees charged and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education. The mandatory disclosure information, as per directions in the AICTE website / Approval Process Handbook, shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the Institution.

11. It shall be mandatory for the Institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.

- As per mandatory Disclosure of APH 2024-27(Annexure-18, page180) Institutions must disclose the following information submitted to Council at the Prominent location on its website.
 - i. Department wise availability of Infrastructure along with approved courses and intake approved by the Council.
 - ii. Faculty details: Department wise: Name& Designation of the faculty members/teaching staff along with their qualification, tenure of service in your organization, total experience, Institution should also disclose Student Faculty Ratio, Cadre Ratio.

iii. Additionally, Audited Financial Statements for every Financial year on year to year basis.

- 13. If the Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and / or misrepresent the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- 14. AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints, to verify adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify any mis-representation, violation of norms & standards, mal-practices etc.
- The Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
- 16. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/-(Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It would not be permissible for the Institution to retain the School / Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students and not to charge fees for the remaining period if a student cancels the admission at any point of time.

17. The Institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of AICTE regulation "Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to Universities imparting technical education" Regulation 2009 (F.No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01/07/2009). In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the notified regulations.

NOTE: If the State Government / UT / DTE / DME has a reservation policy for admission in Technical Education Institutions and the same is applicable to Private & Self-financing Technical Institutions, then the State Government/ UT/ DTE / DME shall ensure that 10 % of Reservation for EWS would be operational from the Academic Year 2020-21. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India.
