EXAMINATION: SCOPUS Gyan Online Test (100 marks) that includes MCQs based on Online classes (50 marks) and Capstone project submission of an article which will be assessed against 50 marks. COURSE COMPLETION CERTIFICATE will be given to all participants against their performance on the MCQ Test that will be administered on 30th April 2022 which must be submitted by participant the same day. However, another COURSE COMPLETION CERTIFICATE WITH CAPSTONE PROJECT will be issued after completion of the Capstone Project. In this way, a participant may get two e-certificates instead of one certificate.

CERTIFICATION: Scorers of 30% and above marks in SCOPUS Gyan Online Test (100 marks), to be conducted at the End of the Course, will be provided with Certificate of Merit.
